Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. **Other HDMI Cat5e extenders have EDID adjustments. The 50040 does not. Why?** The 500450 is transparent to the user and therefore there is no need to modify the EDID. Other vendors have switches for troubleshooting purposes. For example, one EDID switch removes features newer than HDMI 1.3 to supposedly improve compatibility. However, this feature does not seem necessary because the source and the receiver negotiate together and the link is established using the weaker value.
2. **Have you ever heard about IR problems using the 500450 with RC6 IR-Remote, such as Xbox Universal Remote (from Microsoft). It seems that MuxLab's IR Sensor does not supply RC6 codes. Please could you check this with your technical support.** Xbox IR remote uses a 56KHz carrier. MuxLab's IR Sensor (500999) only supports a carrier frequency of 38KHz.
3. **Does the 500450 support digital audio (5.1 or 7.2) from a BluRay player?** Yes. The 500450 supports all audio modes.
