The 500762 HDMI over IP H.264/H.265 PoE Extender Transmitter and Receiver may both be managed by the 500811 ProDigital Network Controller or by the 500762 Web Interface. This document covers how to setup and manage the 500762 via the device's web interface. To manage the 500762 via the 500811 ProDigital Network Controller, reference the 500811 Manual.
